The Fair Trade Cart team members are happy to announce their recent inclusion into the Food and Shelter Team at UCE and we would like to thank you for supporting our efforts in 2014. We feel we have benefited multiple groups across the world as well as in our own community.

All products that we sell are grown or made by workers who receive a fair wage and who enjoy healthy working conditions. In addition to supporting these workers and artisans with our purchases, we were able to send \$300 this fall to the Chute School Healthy Living Club to help educate students about healthy food choices and lifestyles. We plan to continue this support throughout the school year.


This Christmas, for the second year in a row, we gave an additional \$1800 to Chute School to provide \$100 "Food for Less" gift cards to selected families at the school.

What to Do with Hazardous and Other Waste?

Most of us accumulate at some point various waste materials, which should not be disposed of in our regular garbage. These range from paint to automotive products such as old tires, motor oil, antifreeze, etc. and include other chemical products. SWANC (Solid Waste Agency of Northern Cook County) offers excellent advice on what to do with such unwanted items. For automotive products the URL is <http://swancc.org/automotive-products>. For latex paint, see <http://swancc.org/paint>. It also includes a link to Household Chemical Products, which lists one-day events and other advice for oil-based paint, lead-based paint and other chemical substances.

Of course, don't forget that Green Sanctuary has established a site, located in the coat rack area off the UCE lobby, for such non-hazardous items as toothpaste containers, old cell phones, printer ink capsules and several other things, all for recycling.

Finally, you can bring your food scraps to the composting bins just southeast of the church parking lot. If you take advantage of this, please reimburse UCE \$5/person/month to cover our costs.
