

# UCE Member Composting



You can now bring your home food scraps to UCE for commercial composting. Please sign up in the church office. The monthly fee to UCE is \$5 per person, \$20 max per household.

Collective Resource, Inc. will be providing a 32-gallon green totes labeled COMPOST at the south end of the parking lot for food scrap collection.

Home Food Scrap Collection Guidelines:

You can commercial compost all of the following:

## Foods

Meat, bones, fish, and seafood

Seafood shells

Fruits and vegetables

Eggs and eggshells

Milk, cheese, and other dairy

Dressings, condiments, sauces, and soups

Flour, bread, pasta, rice, and pastries

Coffee grounds and filters

Nuts and nut shells

Spices, oils, and fats

## Compostable Disposables

100% Paper plates and napkins

Corn based plastic cups and bottles

Popsicle sticks and skewers

Paper towels, wax paper, parchment paper, and toothpicks

Remove all the labels

from the fruit's skins

Please gather your food scraps in a countertop container, lined with a paper or a biobag and dump it when full into the UCE outside bin. **Do not try to carry a Biobag outside the container in your car. Please do not use the containers in the church kitchen to empty your household compost.** Home pickup service is also available, if that is more convenient for your household.
